The Fourth New Hampshire belonged to General Horatio G. Wright's brigade, T. W. Sherman's division, the land force which co-operated with Du Pont's fleet in the reduction of Hilton Head. * (See page 64.) After its capture, Hilton Head was strongly fortified, and held by the Union authorities throughout the war.
