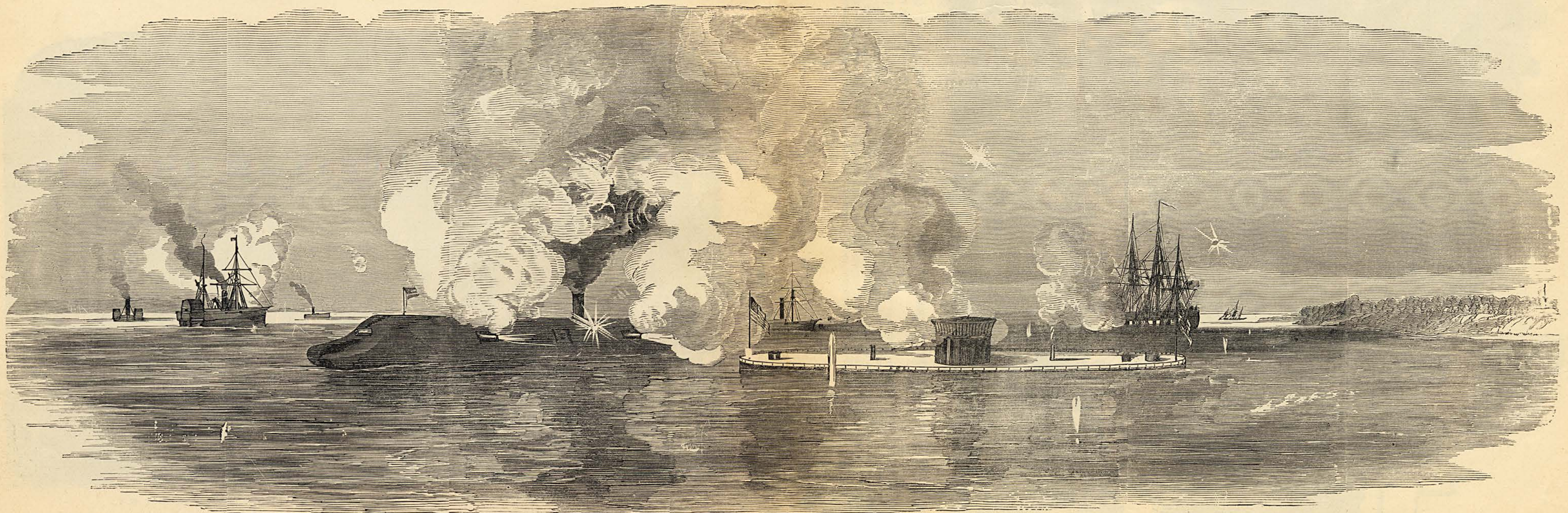




MERRIMAC. CUMBERLAND. CONGRESS. BATTERIES AND FEDERAL CAMP AT NEWPORT NEWS.
