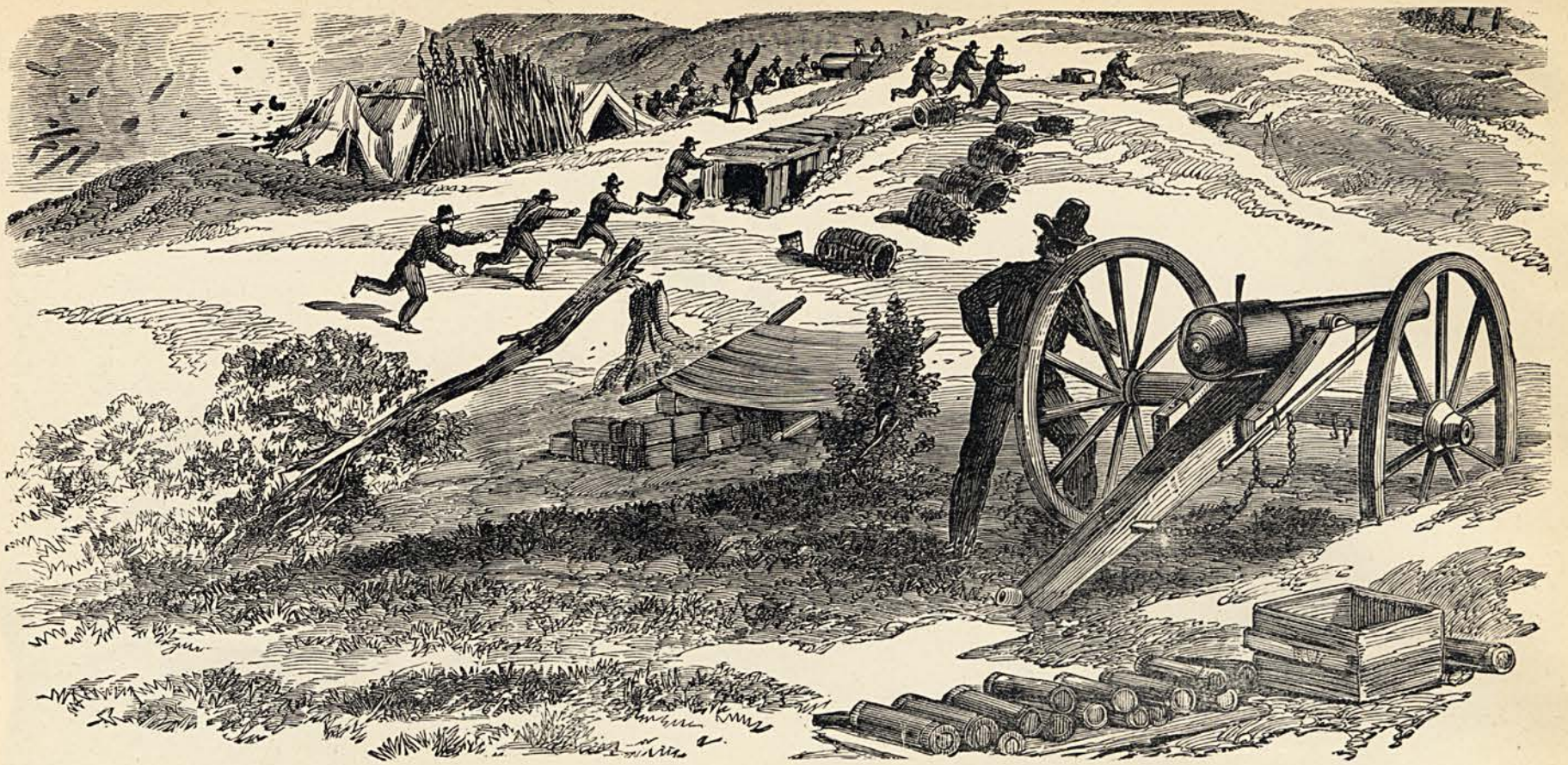

After the explosion of the Union mine under a Confederate fort on Jackson road, June 25, the enemy retaliated by firing several small mines they had planted near the Union works. Little damage was done by these small explosions beyond giving the besiegers more than a good scare and a vigorous shaking up.
